- ❖ Bordered to Thailand, Laos, Vietnam, and Gulf of Thailand.
- ❖ Phnom Penh is the capital city (2.2 Million inhabitants)
- ❖ Land Area : 181,035 km<sup>2</sup>
- ❖ Population: 14.8 Million
- ❖ Climate, tropical monsoon with Dry season (Nov. to Mar.) and Rainy season (Apr. to Oct.)

**Tonlé Sap is the largest freshwater lake in Southeast Asia and is the ecological hotspot that was designated as a UNESCO biosphere in 1997.**

## Tonlé Sap Lake

### Bird Sanctuary

Prèk Toal on the Tonlé Sap Lake is the biggest bird reserve in Southeast Asia. It is home to thousands of migrant birds including Whiskered Terns, Darters, Cormorants, and Spot Billed Pelicans. Of great interest are the rare Adjutant and Painted Storks.

In addition, Cambodia has one of only two nesting sites for the beautiful and extremely rare Sarus Crane. Ang Trapeang Thmor is a reservoir to the North.

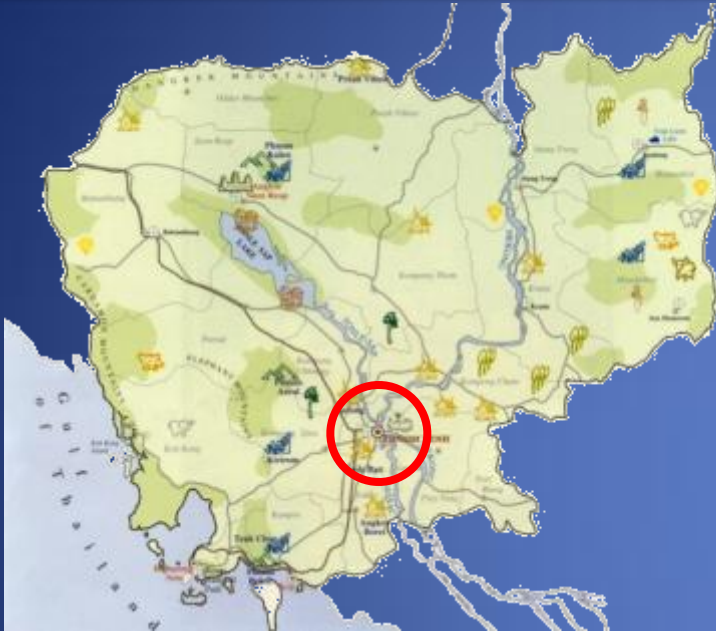

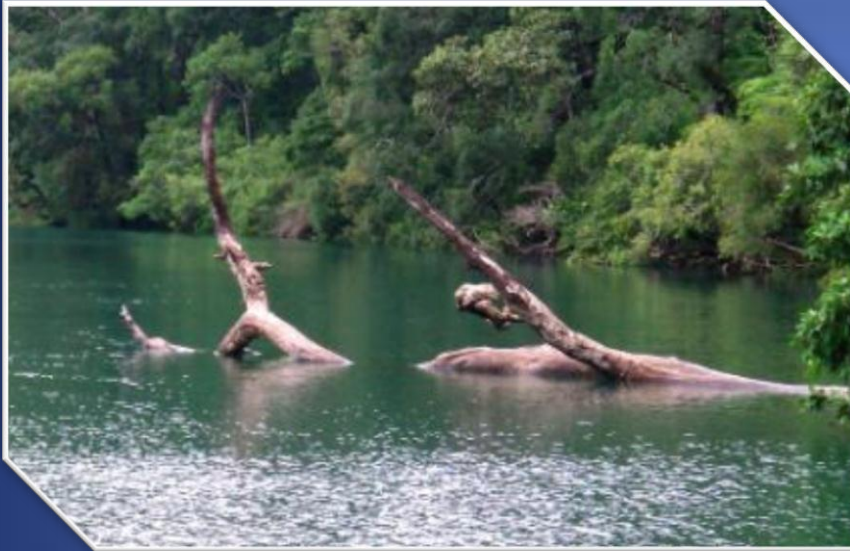

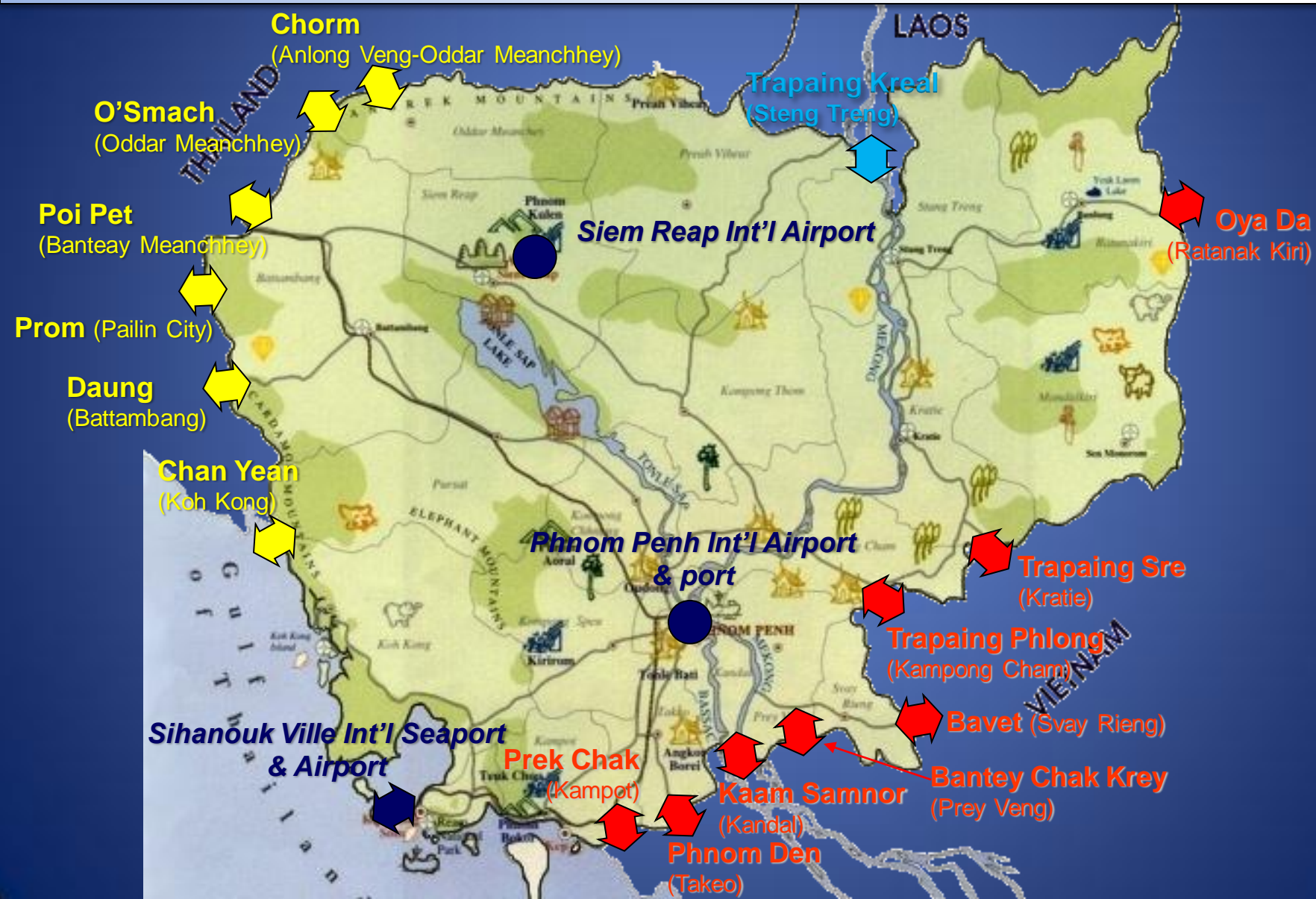

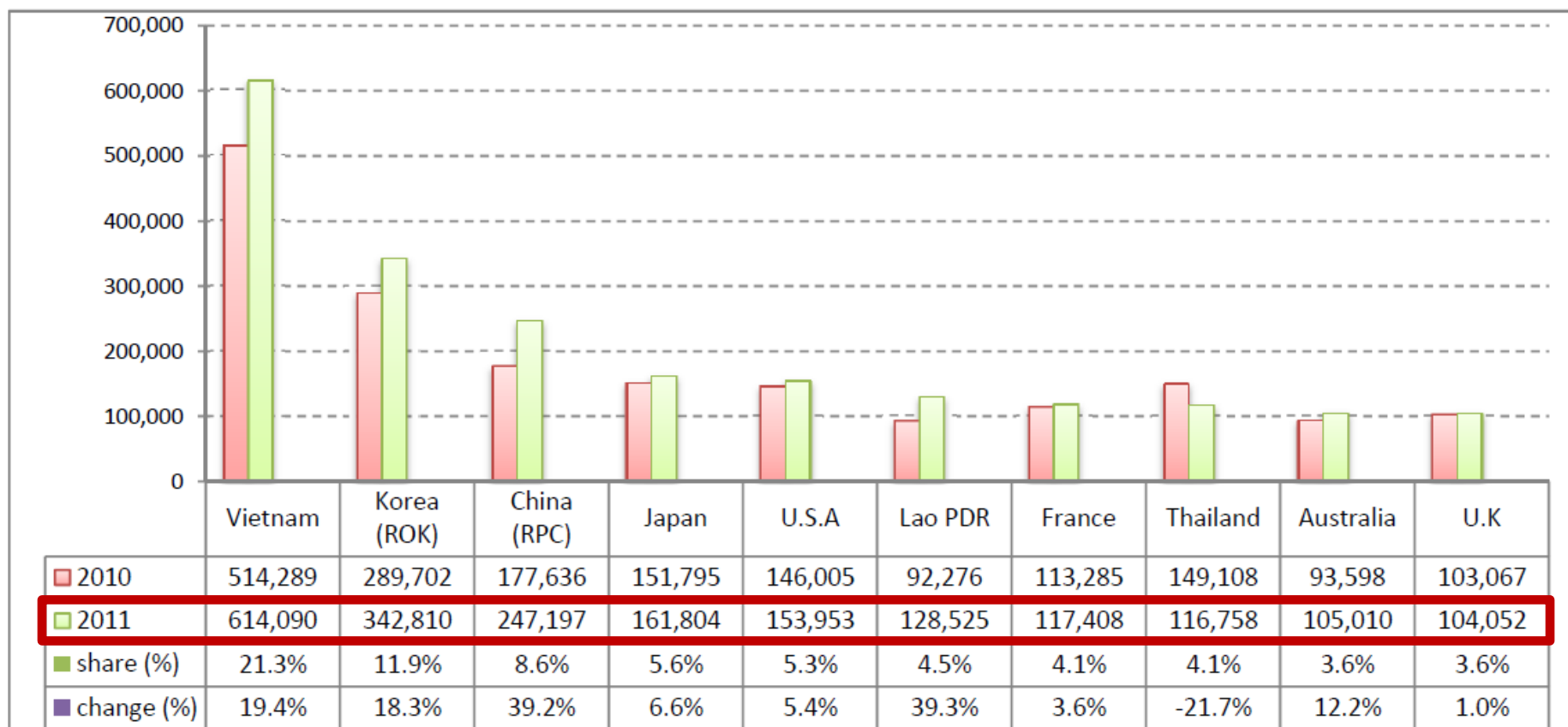


## International visitor arrivals from 1993-2011

## Top ten markets arrivals in 2011



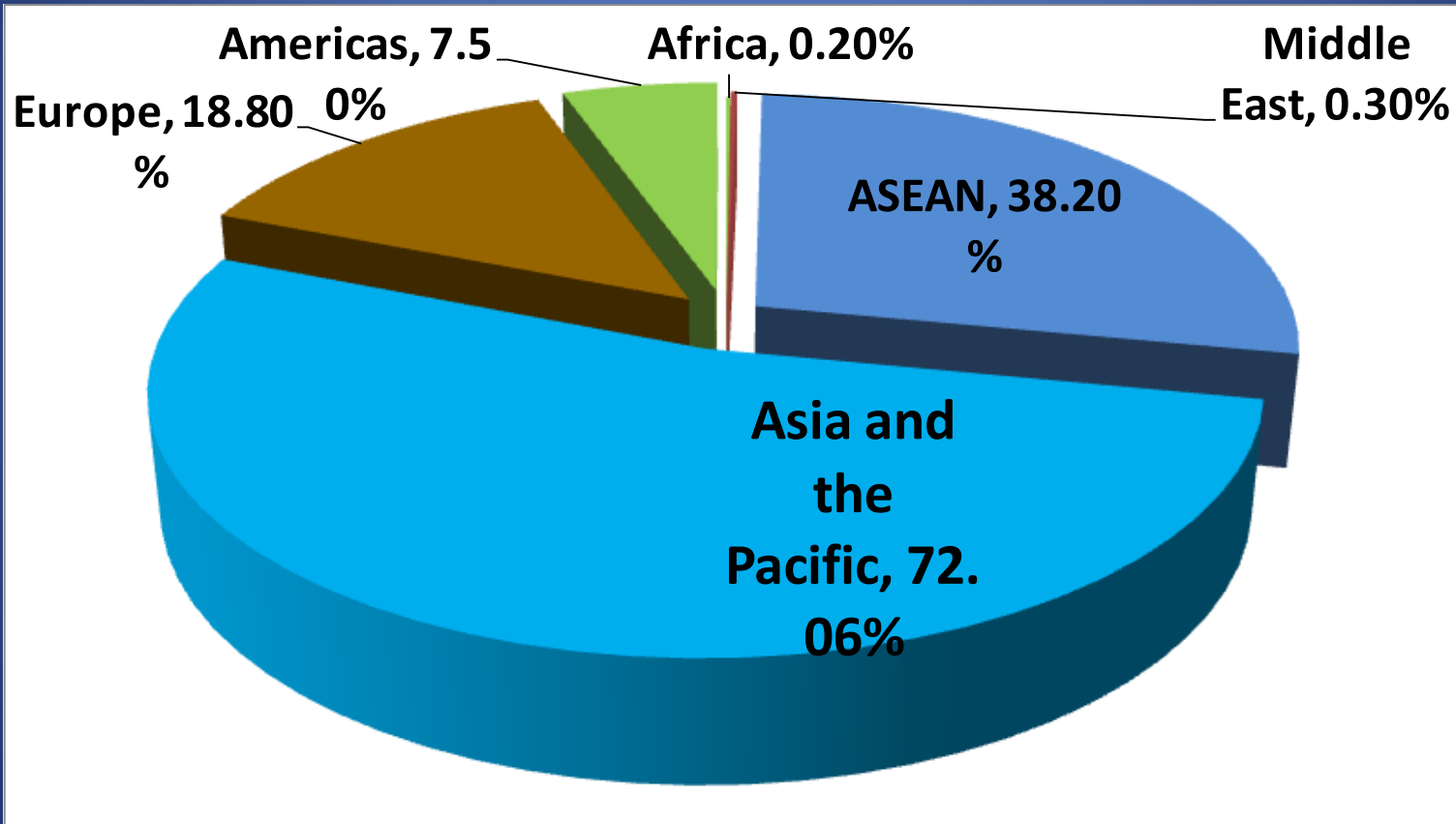

### International Tourist Arrivals by Regions in 2011



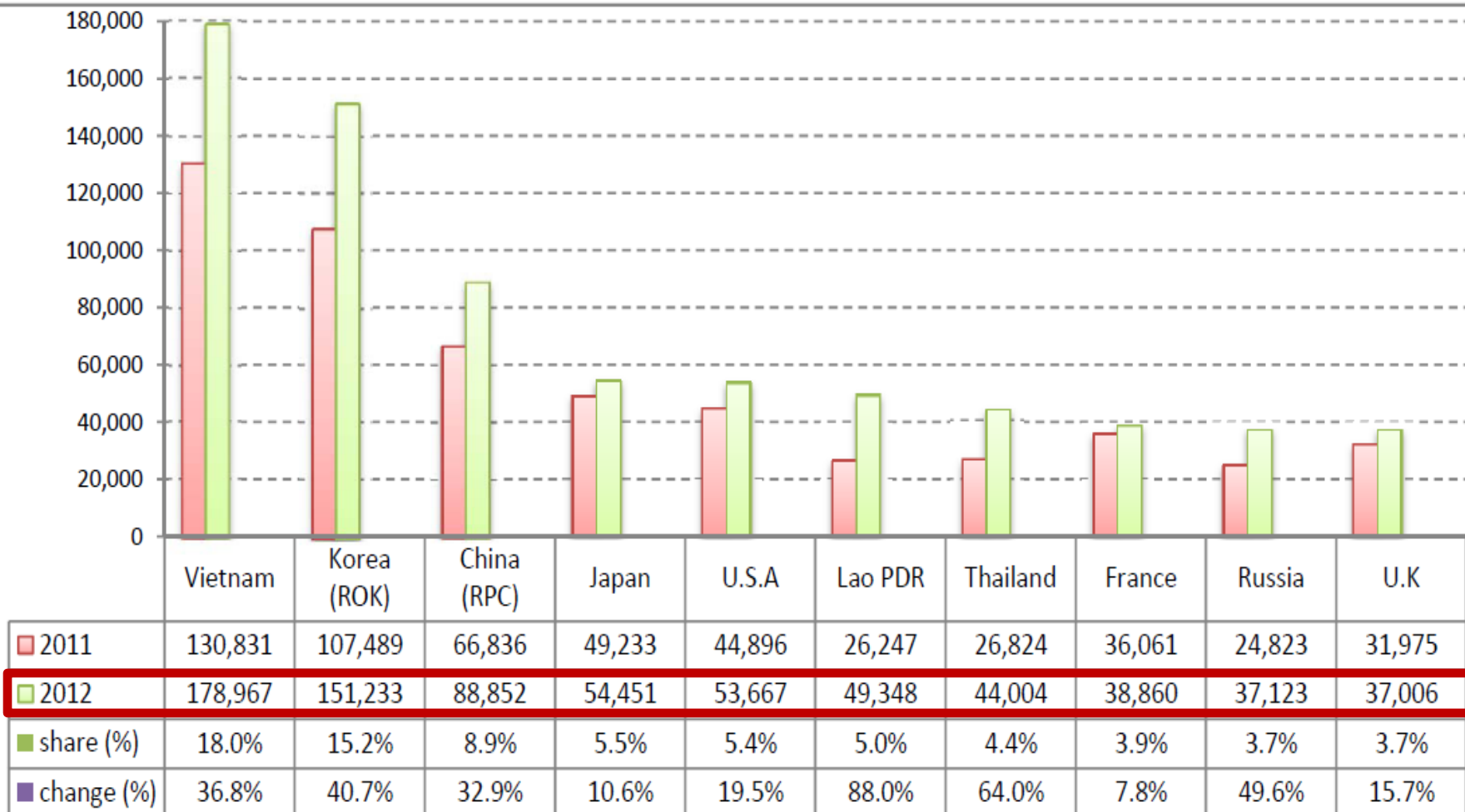

## Jan-Mar 2012 Top Ten Market



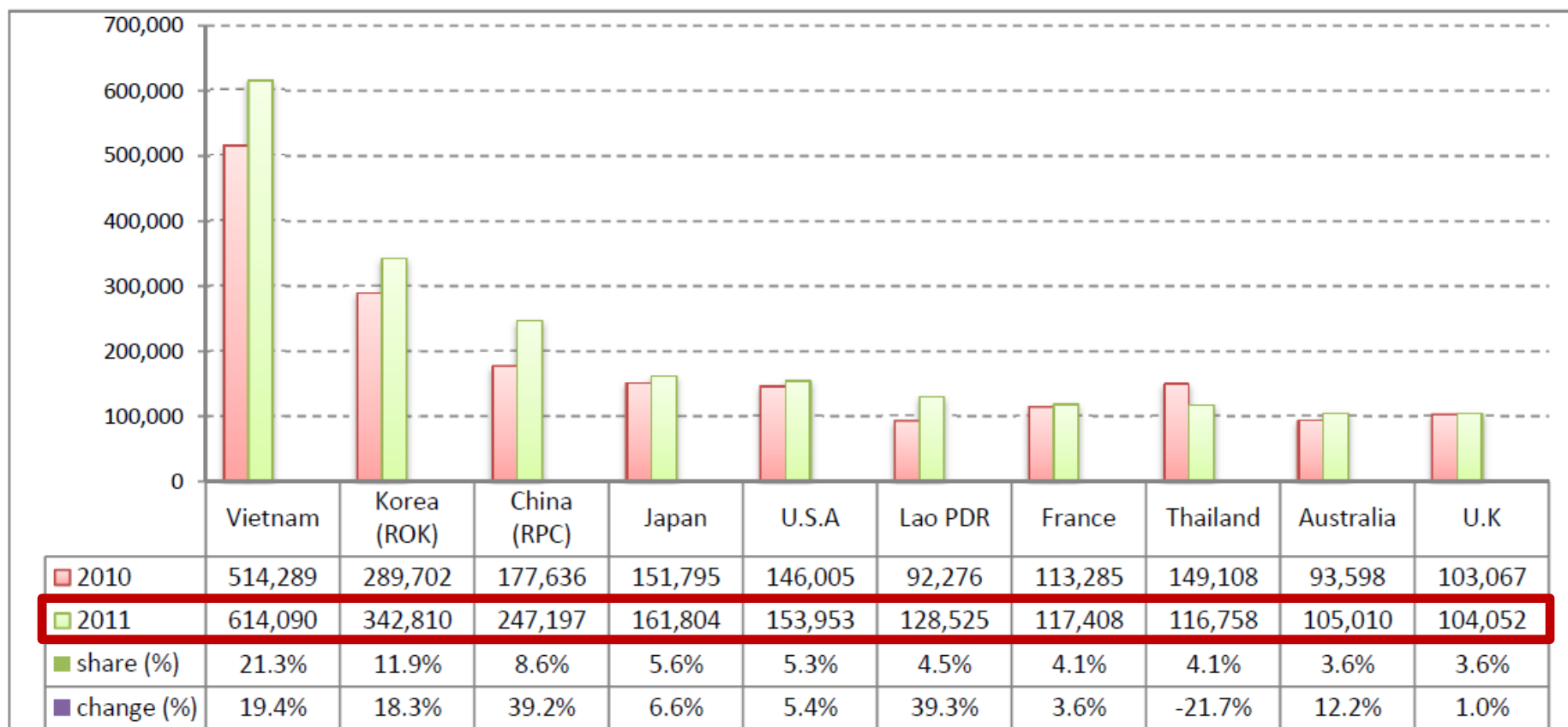
### Top ten markets arrivals in Jan-Mar 2012
